How to Set Up Wi-Fi



Setting up Wi-Fi on your device.

At the main screen, swipe up to access all of the apps located on your device.

- Tap on the Settings icon, then tap on "Network & Internet"
- 2 Move the Wi-Fi switch to On
- 3 Tap "Add Network" and type in "UEISTUDENT"**
- For Identity, input your information in the format "FirstInitialLastNameStudentID"
- For Password, input your information in the format "StudentIDNumberLast4SSN"
- 6 Tap "Connect"
- Check connection by looking for the word "connected" under UEISTUDENT





Once you have logged in to the Student Portal in your browser:


Tap on the Bookmark icon to save the Student Portal in your browser

Select "Save as Icon" on screen




You can also save the Student Portal as an icon on your phone from your home screen.







There are multiple ways within SOAR Virtual Classroom to communicate with your instructor and classmates.



Navigating Hybrid Learning



On-Campus Lab Days

Attending your scheduled lab days are mandatory and important for your success. In lab, you will learn and practice the skills needed for your career.



SOAR Virtual Classroom Days

SOAR Virtual Classroom days are your non-lab days. Online days will include classroom activities, live Zoom lecture hours in SOAR Virtual Classroom, and live chat with your instructor. Online classes are designed to prepare you for the next lab, theory and exams. You will receive daily assignments to reinforce topics in lecture.



Daily Tasks

You will:

- Check your announcements
- Complete daily assignment
- Participate in discussion boards
- Check your email



Homework

Homework is very important and must be completed throughout the week. The topics assigned will help reinforce learning objectives from lab and theory.

- Complete skills check-offs.


*On-Campus Lab Days attendance is mandatory. You will not be able to graduate in your field of study without successful completion of lab skills.
